Rules for Judges & Qualifiers

NCPA – 26th April, 10th May, 31st May, 14th June, 19th July and 09th August.

This show is a qualifier for N.C.P.A Pony of the Year Show. First and second prize-winners will qualify. Affiliation number 230/20

TRADTIONAL GYPSY COB ASSOCIATION (TOYS) – 26th April, 31st May, 14th June and 09th August shows. TGCA Classes at Urmston & District Riding Club – Affiliation No 20/2604/ULT, 20/3105/ULT,20/1406/ULT & 20/0908/ULT

All in hand and ridden classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed finals at TGCA National Championship Show, The Traditional of the Year Show "TOYS". Full details can be obtained from the TGCA website: www.tgca.co.uk

TGCA breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breeds Finals at the Gypsy Cob Associations (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Part Bred classes are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at TOYS. The exhibit must have one parent that is pure bred traditional gypsy cob. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with metal bit and chain lead as per current TGCA rulebook.

Current TGCA members must present their membership card qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members must receive qualification card from judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including memberships, horse registrations and showing rules, contained within the members handbook.

TGCA Championships: 26th April, 31st May, 14th June and 09th August

Quest for a Star Championship: $TGC - 1^{st}$, 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} from TGCA classes above may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship as per the below rule:

Only current TGCA members and horse/pony that is already registered can exhibit in this championship. Membership card and Members qualification card (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The champion and Reserve quality for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

Go for Glory Championship: $PB - 1^{st}$, 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} form the TGCA Part Bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory Championship. For 2020 TOYS qualifiers, the handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA Members/registered on the date of the show. The champion and reserve qualify for Crowning Glory Championships at TOYS.

TRAILBLAZERS - 26th April, 10th May, 31st May and 14th June. The 4 highest placed combinations will qualify from each Showing & Working Hunter Qualifier for the Trailblazers Championship Finals regardless of the number of entries in the Qualifier. Once a Competitor has qualified at a Trailblazers Qualifier they will be issued by the venue with a congratulations letter telling them that they have qualified. The Competitor will then have the choice to take up the qualification or not. Should the Competitor decide to accept the qualification for the Championship Finals, they should purchase a direct qualification card from the venue at a cost of £12 per card.

Cards are issued per qualifying partnership and will permit them to enter any showing or working hunter class for which they are eligible to compete in, at the Championship Finals. Once the qualification card has been received the competitor must send this onto the Trailblazers Show Secretary (details on the qualification card) in order to be sent a Trailblazers Championship Finals schedule at the beginning of June prior to the Championships.

THE SHOWING REGISTER SHOWING FINALS (TSR) – 26th April, 10th May, 31st May, 14th June, 19th July, 09th August & 06th September.

TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2020 TSR NAF Five Star Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR **NAF Five Star** Riders Finals – 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification flyer in the ring.

TSR **NAF Five Star** In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand sheet will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their sheet signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/

Equifest & BSHA Intro Championships - With a TSR qualification flyer you can also enter Equifest 19-22 Aug at Peterbrough www.equifest.org.uk & the BSHA Intro Champs in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final.

CHAPS – 10th May and 19th July shows - AFFILICATION NUMBER: (20091)

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. (20091) Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 12th – 15th August 2020. Shows held on or after 09th August 2020 of Championship show will count as 2021 qualifiers. The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifying Classes: Class 3: Novice Horse & Pony / Class 19a: In hand Open Coloured Youngstock / Class 27a: In-Hand Open Coloured / Class 30: In-Hand Veteran Senior Pony or Horse / Class 38a: Ridden Open Coloured. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Only "Coloureds" horses and ponies (as defined in the current CHAPS UK Members Handbook) may compete these classes. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

EQUIFEST – 26th April, 10th May, 31st May, 14th June & 19th July

This Show is affiliated to Equifest. The <u>two</u> highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the relevant Equifest Championship to be held at the East of England Showground on the 19^{th} – 23^{rd} August 2020.
