Rules for Judges & Qualifiers

NCPA – 25th April, 23rd May, 13th June, 4th July, 1st August .

This show is a qualifier for N.C.P.A Pony of the Year Show. First and second prize-winners will qualify. Affiliation number 230/20

CHAPS –23rd May and13th June shows - AFFILIATION NUMBER: (21091)

This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. (21091) Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However, in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 12th – 14th August 2021. Shows held on or after 09th August 2021 of Championship show will count as 2022 qualifiers. The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifying Classes: Class 27: Novice Horse & Pony / Class 16: In hand Open Coloured Youngstock / Class 23: In-Hand Open Coloured / Class 19: In-Hand Veteran Senior Pony or Horse / Class 29: Ridden Veteran Senior Pony or Horse / Class 39: Ridden Open Coloured. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings. Only "Coloureds" horses and ponies (as defined in the current CHAPS UK Members Handbook) may compete these classes. All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception.

TRAILBLAZERS -25th April, 23rd May, 13th June, 4th July show's only. The 4 highest placed combinations will qualify from each Showing & Working Hunter Qualifier for the Trailblazers Championship Finals regardless of the number of entries in the Qualifier. Once a Competitor has qualified at a Trailblazers Qualifier they will be issued by the venue with a congratulations letter telling them that they have qualified. The Competitor will then have the choice to take up the qualification or not. Should the Competitor decide to accept the qualification for the Championship Finals, they should purchase a direct qualification card from the venue at a cost of £12 per card.

Cards are issued per qualifying partnership and will permit them to enter any showing or working hunter class for which they are eligible to compete in, at the Championship Finals. Once the qualification card has been received the competitor must send this onto the Trailblazers Show Secretary (details on the qualification card) in order to be sent a Trailblazers Championship Finals schedule at the beginning of June prior to the Championships.

TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB ASSOCIATION (TOYS) – 23rd May, 13th June shows

All in hand and ridden classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed finals at TGCA National Championship Show, The Traditional of the Year Show "TOYS". Full details can be obtained from the TGCA website: www.tgca.co.uk

TGCA breed classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breeds Finals at the Gypsy Cob Associations (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all traditional gypsy cobs. Part Bred classes are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the part bred finals at TOYS. The exhibit must have one parent that is pure bred traditional gypsy cob. Stallions – All stallions (four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA stallion evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two MUST be shown in a stallion bridle with metal bit and chain lead as per current TGCA rulebook.

Current TGCA members must present their membership card qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members must receive qualification card from judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including memberships, horse registrations and showing rules, contained within the members handbook.

TGCA Championships: 23rd May and 13th June show's

Quest for a Star Championship: TGC – 1st, 2nd and 3rd from TGCA classes above may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship as per the below rule:

Only current TGCA members and horse/pony that is already registered can exhibit in this championship. Membership card and Members qualification card (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

Go for Glory Championship: PB – 1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA Part Bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory Championship. For 2021 TOYS qualifiers, the handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA Members/registered on the date of the show. The champion and reserve qualify for Crowning Glory Championships at TOYS.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR UDRC SHOWS 2021

It is imperative that we keep everyone safe during these times. The committee and organisers have taken steps to ensure the safety of all competitors and cannot accept responsibility for any illness or injury. Anyone found to not comply with the rules set out as follows will be asked to leave the showground and membership with UDRC will be retracted.

By entering the UDRC Shows on the 2021 it is implied that you have accepted the following terms and conditions;

- By entering you are consenting to sharing your details with the relevant authorities for Tracking and Tracing purposes should there be a risk of infection.
- You MUST NOT ATTEND IF YOU OR A MEMBER OF YOUR HOUSEHOLD/SUPPORT BUBBLE HAVE DEVELOPED ANY SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19. These include: high temperature/fever/continued cough/loss or change in sense of smell or taste/shortness of breath. If you have been contacted for tracing purposes you must not attend and you should self-isolate. We are encouraging individuals to complete rapid lateral flow testing. Any individual with a positive test MUST self-isolate.
- Individuals are limited to one groom/one driver per combination. No spectators will be allowed on the showground. Cars/trailers and lorries will be checked upon entry to the showground.
- All competitors must be members before competing at ALL UDRC shows. Competitors will be unable to join on the day. Membership for the 25th April 2021 show will close on the 23rd April 2021.
- If you have not received your combination number by the 24th April 2021 then you will be required to collect your number on the morning of the show.
- Pre- Entries are encouraged via the website. Competitors intending to enter on the day will require their own masks and the correct fees for the entries. No change will be given. Pens will not be provided, please bring your own.
- Individuals attending the UDRC showground will be required to adhere to the traffic flow system.
- The use of face masks is encouraged and individuals are asked to responsibly use hand sanitiser when required. Face masks cannot be worn whilst riding.
- Individuals are required to maintain the 2m distance at all times unless in your support bubble.
- All horses competing at UDRC have to be up to date with their vaccinations. If your horse is showing any symptoms at the showground, you will be asked to leave.

It remains YOUR responsibility to adhere to these rules for your own safety.



CLUB RULES

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY: The Trustees, Organisers, Urmston & District Riding Club, Committee or any persons acting on their behalf will not accept responsibility for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders or spectators or any person, animal, or property whatsoever from any cause.

1. Membership is open until the 30th April 2021. Members will not be eligible to join after this date. Membership ages are as follows: LR 10 years & Under, FR 10 years – 12 years, Junior 12-18 years and Senior 18 years + as of the 1st January 2021.
2. Correct standard hard hats must be worn by all riders at all times in all events.
3. Whips exceeding 30inches are not allowed.
4. Riders must walk on the showground at all times unless in the designated warm up area.
5. The Judges decision is final.
6. It is the competitor's responsibility to be prepared for the class when it is called. If the competitor cannot enter the ring when it is called they must inform the Judge or Steward of the circumstances. If the class is called and the competitor misses the class no refunds will be given.
7. Entry fees will only be refunded should a class be cancelled.
8. All colts/stallions must be handled by an individual 16 or over.
9. Competitors are the only people permitted in the ring.
10. The decision of the Committee is final and binding.
11. Entry fees must be paid before any horse or rider enters the ring.
12. Non Members cannot win any cup, trophy or shield. Non Members cannot compete in the Grand Supreme Show and will not be nominated for the Rising Star Award.
13. All complaints or objections must be made in writing to the club secretary within 24 hours of the incident with a fee of £20.00 which will be refunded if upheld.
14. Any competitor deemed not in control of their animal will be asked to leave the showground. All dogs must be kept on leads.
